

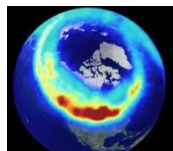

Our Aurora Borealis is spectacular! Yellowknife is located directly under the Aurora Oval which circles the polar regions of the globe where the shimmering green lights of the Aurora Borealis are at their most brilliant. The Aurora Borealis, also known as the Northern Lights, are giant electrical storms generated by solar flares from the sun reacting with the earth's magnetic field. Even though the lights of the Aurora Borealis are 100 - 500 kilometers above the earth's upper atmosphere, our guests often feel like they can reach out and touch them. Combined with its clear cold nights, Yellowknife's favorable geographic location makes it the best place in the world to see the Aurora.



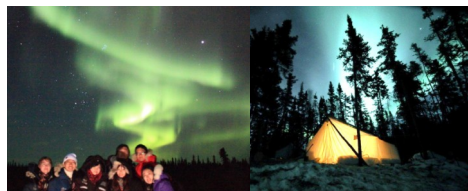

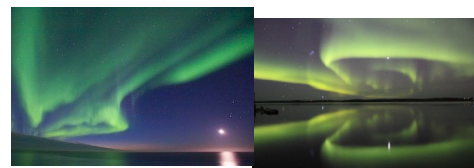

Beck's Kennels has been hosting visitors in Yellowknife since 1989. Come meet world-renowned dog musher, Grant Beck and experience the eagerness and power of a professional team of dogs as you traverse our beautiful Northern wilderness trails.

Beck's Kennels is famous for dog sled rides. Owner, Grant Beck has been mushing dogs since age seven, when his first job was delivering groceries by dog team in the remote village of Fort Resolution, NWT. By age twelve, Grant was travelling by himself in the bush with his dog team, learning to live safely and comfortably in temperatures as low as -40C.

Since running and winning his first race at nine years old, Grant has put together an impressive career with hundreds of trophies and wins.

The headlines began with the first of his four wins at the Canadian Championship in 1978. Grant was the 10-dog World Champion by 1981 and was winning races of up to 300 miles throughout the United States.

In 1991, Grant's international reputation soared when he started racing the 700 km Alpirod with many years of top 3 finishes. Over 11 seasons in Europe, Grant went on to win the Pirena 2000 Dog Sled Race in the Pyrenees. In 2005 he finished a

strong third in La Grande Odyssee Savoie Mont Blanc, one of the toughest dog sled races in the world with its difficult mountain terrain. There are many more races like the International Pedigree Stage Stop Race, which starts in Jackson Hole, Wyoming, still in his future.

But it's not just about racing at Beck's Kennels; for years Grant has been mentoring aspiring young dog mushers, and working with the schools, teaching kids the traditional methods of dog sledding and living on the land, combined with modern changes. He has lead dog sled expeditions for schoolchildren and their elders all over the Northwest Territories.

At Beck's Kennels, we are proud of our heritage and Grant's racing success. But even more than that, we admire and respect our dogs. Grant's racing dogs are amongst the toughest and the best in the world. With many awards for 'Best Cared For Dogsled Team' they are fit, happy and healthy.
